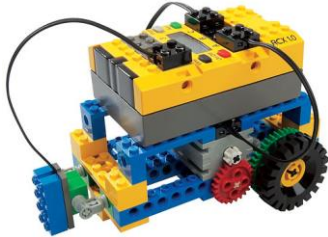

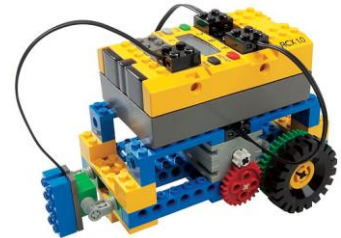

Students work in teams to build a robot using LEGO parts and program it using ROBOLAB software. Robots will be designed to perform a specific function and will compete with each other in an event to test that behavior. Students who participate will:

- Use LEGO and ROBOLAB materials: something familiar with a technology twist
- Apply their creativity and ingenuity to solve tough robotic problems
- Participate in a friendly, competitive event

This camp is open to Sanilac County students in grades 5th through 8th. Students may register individually or as a team of two students. Students who register individually will be assigned a partner.
