The Marlette Board of Education adopted the following policy at its September 14, 2015 meeting:

Effective October 1, 2015, students will only be allowed to charge up to \$20.00 on their meal account. Students will be given an alternate meal until the charges have been paid.

In addition, on July 27, 2015, the Board made changes to the Jr/Sr High School Student Handbook Participation in Commencement Exercises section (page 8) which states:

A student who has met all requirements for graduation by graduation day and has paid all fees and fines may participate in the Commencement services.

The fees and fines include outstanding food service account balances.

The current system is a debit card system. Parents/Guardians are encouraged to put money on their student's account so they can draw from this balance for meals and snacks. Payments can be made at the registers, at the school offices, or online via Efunds for Schools found in Skyward under the Food Service tab.

Students who qualify for free meals will continue to receive meals. Milk is included with a full meal. Students purchasing milk alone will be charged \$.40.

Students with a negative balance may still purchase a meal with cash.

Students who qualify for reduced meals will need to pay \$.30 for breakfast and \$.40 for lunch.

Ala Carte items must be paid for with cash or a positive balance on the student's account.

No change will be given in the lines after October 1. Additional funds will be applied to the student's account.

Notifications of negative balances will be sent to the parent/guardian email address on file weekly, or if no email address is available, by letter monthly. Please confirm email addresses are accurate. Parents/Guardians may also access balance information in Skyward under the Food Service tab.

Parents can request to have blocks set on their accounts to prevent purchase of ala carte items or double entrees.

Parents/Guardians who have students with negative balances can contact the Superintendent's Office to set up a payment plan. Office numbers are 635-4923 and 635-7429.
